

China Power System Warranty

Coverage

Product Warranted

This Warranty applies to new Power Systems that are used in hybrid bus applications in China, sold by Cummins and delivered to the first user on or after January 1, 2012.

Base Power System Warranty

The Base Power System Warranty covers any failures of the Power System that result, under normal use and service, from a defect in material or factory workmanship (Warrantable Failure). This Coverage begins with the sale of the Power System by Cummins and ends one year after the date of delivery of the Power System to the first user.

Cummins parts are identified by a Cummins Part Number either marked on the part or listed on the Parts Catalog for the particular Power System Serial Number.

Extended Power System Warranty

The Extended Power System Warranty covers Warrantable Failures of the Generator Motor, Power Inverter, Battery (including Battery Management System) and Power System Controls. This Coverage begins with the sale of the Power System by Cummins and ends three years or 150,000 kilometers* after the date of delivery of the Power System to the first user.

* Whichever occurs first, after the Warranty start date.

Battery includes Master Service Disconnect, Fans, Enclosure, Battery Modules, Battery Current Sensing Module, Battery Electrical Distribution Module, Low Voltage Harness, High Voltage Harness, Battery System Control Module, Cooling Plenum, Backing Plates, Air Temperature Sensor and Electrical Connectors.

Generator Motor includes Generator Motor, Generator Motor Shaft, Position Sensor, Dust Seal, Bearings, Housings, Coolant Manifold and Electrical Connectors.

Power Inverter includes the Inverter and Coolant Fittings.

Power System Controls includes the Power System Control Module and Power System Control Module Software.

These Warranties are made to all Owners in the chain of distribution and Coverage continues to all subsequent Owners until the end of the periods of Coverage.

Cummins Responsibilities

During The Base Power System Warranty And The Extended Power System Warranty

Cummins will pay for all parts and labor needed to repair the damage to the Power System resulting from a Warrantable Failure.

Cummins will pay for the lubricating oil, antifreeze, filter elements, belts, hoses and other maintenance items that are not reusable due to the Warrantable Failure.

Cummins will pay for reasonable labor costs for Power System removal and reinstallation when necessary to repair a Warrantable Failure.

Cummins will pay for the repair or, at its option, replacement of the defective Covered Part and any Covered Part damaged by a Warrantable Failure of the defective Covered Part.

Cummins will pay reasonable costs for towing a vehicle disabled by a Warrantable Failure to the nearest authorized repair location. In lieu of towing expenses, Cummins will pay reasonable costs for mechanics to travel to and from the location of the vehicle, including meals, mileage and lodging, when the repair is performed at the site of the failure.

Owner Responsibilities

During The Base Power System And The Extended Power System Warranties

Owner is responsible for the cost of lubricating oil, antifreeze, filter elements and other maintenance items replaced during Warranty repairs unless such items are not reusable due to the Warrantable Failure.

Owner is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Power System as specified in the applicable Cummins Operation and Maintenance Manuals. Owner is also responsible for providing proof that all recommended maintenance has been performed.

Before the expiration of the applicable Warranty, Owner must notify a Cummins distributor, authorized dealer or other repair location approved by Cummins of any Warrantable Failure and make the Power System available for repair by such facility.

Service locations are listed on the Cummins Worldwide Service Locator at cummins.com.

Owner is responsible for communication expenses, meals, lodging and similar costs incurred as a result of a Warrantable Failure.

Owner is responsible for non-Power System repairs and for "downtime" expenses, fines, cargo damage, all applicable taxes, all business costs and other losses resulting from a Warrantable Failure.

Limitations

A separate Warranty applies to Engine related components; details can be found at Worldwide All Bus 3381278. Warranty claims on Power System components should be filed using the Power System Serial Number (PSN). The PSN can typically be found on a data plate near the vehicle VIN. Warranty claims for Engine related repairs should be filed separately using the Engine Serial Number.

Cummins is not responsible for failures or damage resulting from what Cummins determines to be abuse or neglect, including, but not limited to: operation without adequate coolants or lubricants; overfueling; overspeeding; lack of maintenance of lubricating, cooling or intake systems; improper storage, starting, warm-up, run-in or shutdown practices; unauthorized modifications of the Power System.

Any unauthorized modifications to the Power System could void the Warranty.

There is no demonstration period on bus applications.

This Warranty does not apply to accessories that bear the name of another company or do not have a Cummins part number. Such non-Warranted accessories may include, alternators, starters, fans, air conditioning compressors, drive clutches, filters, transmissions, torque converters, vacuum pumps, power steering pumps and air compressors.

Failures of belts and hoses supplied by Cummins are covered for the first year from the date of delivery to the first user during the Base Power System Warranty.

Parts used to repair a Warrantable Failure may be new Cummins parts, Cummins approved rebuilt parts or repaired parts. Cummins is not responsible for failures resulting from the use of parts not approved by Cummins. All Cummins Power System parts will be identified by a Cummins part number.

A new Cummins or Cummins approved rebuilt part used to repair a Warrantable Failure assumes the identity of the part it replaced and is entitled to the remaining Coverage hereunder.

Cummins Inc. reserves the right to interrogate Electronic Control Module (ECM) data for purposes of failure analysis.

CUMMINS DOES NOT COVER WEAR OR WEAROUT OF COVERED PARTS.

THESE WARRANTIES SET FORTH HEREINAFTER ARE THE SOLE WARRANTIES MADE BY CUMMINS IN REGARD TO THESE POWER SYSTEMS. CUMMINS MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED. SUCH DISCLAIMED WARRANTIES INCLUDING, BUT NOT BEING LIMITED TO, ANY WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

This Warranty gives you specific legal rights and you may also have other rights, which vary from state to state or country to country.
