Coverage

Products Warranted

This Warranty applies to ReCon® B3.9/B5.9/ISB/QSB/B GAS PLUS/BLPG PLUS/C8.3/ISC/QSC/C GAS PLUS/ISL/ISL G/QSL/L GAS PLUS series Engines originally manufactured or distributed by Cummins Inc. (“Cummins”) that are remanufactured by Cummins ReCon® business, delivered to the first user on or after April 4, 2014 and marketed by Cummins ReCon® business anywhere in the world where Cummins approved service is available under the trademark “Cummins” or “Cummins ReCon®”.

Base Engine Warranty

This Base Engine Warranty covers any Warrantable Failure of Cummins ReCon® B, C and L Series Engines that results, under normal use and service, from defects in material or factory workmanship (Warrantable Failure). Warranty Coverage for Cummins ReCon® B, C and L Series Engines is as follows:

** For B3.9, B5.9, QSB, B GAS PLUS, BLPG PLUS, C8.3, C GAS PLUS, QSC, QSL, ISL G, L GAS PLUS Industrial applications, if the 2,000 hours limit is exceeded during the first year, coverage continues until the end of the first year.		

Cummins Responsibilities

Cummins will pay for all Cummins parts and labor required to repair the Engine as a result of a Warrantable Failure.

During the ReCon® Engine Warranty, for Industrial applications, travel is covered up to six hours when a vehicle is disabled as a result of a Warrantable Failure.

Only Cummins ReCon® Components or new genuine Cummins parts and assemblies will be used in making the repair. Cummins will also pay costs for reasonable maintenance items (oil, filters, antifreeze) that have been damaged, or require replacement, as a result of a Warrantable Failure.

All labor costs will be paid in accordance with Cummins published Standard Repair Time guidelines. Labor must be performed by an authorized Cummins Distributor or Dealer.

Cummins will pay reasonable labor costs for Engine removal and reinstallation when necessary to make the Warranty repair.

Owner Responsibilities

Owner is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Engine as specified in the applicable Cummins Operation and Maintenance Manuals.

Prior to the expiration of the applicable Warranty, Owner must give notice of any Warrantable Failure to a Cummins Distributor or authorized Dealer or other repair location approved by Cummins, and deliver the Engine to such facility for repair. Locations are listed in the Cummins Worldwide Service Locator at cummins.com.

Owner is responsible for communication expenses, meals, towing, lodging, travel and incidental costs incurred by Owner or employees of Owner as a result of a Warrantable Failure.

Owner is responsible for “downtime” expenses, cargo damage and all business costs and losses resulting from a Warrantable Failure. **Cummins is not responsible for incidental or consequential damages.**

Limitations

Cummins is not responsible for failures resulting from Owner or Operator abuse or neglect, such as: operation without adequate coolant, fuel or lubricants; overfueling; overspeeding; lack of maintenance of lubricating, cooling or air intake systems; improper storage, starting, warm-up, run-in or shut-down practices; excessive progressive damage. Cummins is also not responsible for failures caused by incorrect fuel or dirt, water or other contaminants in the fuel.

Unless supplied with the Engines, starters, generators, alternators, flywheels, flywheel housing, ring gears, fan hubs and other similar items are not covered by this Warranty.

Before a claim for excessive oil consumption will be considered, Owner must submit adequate documentation to show that consumption exceeds Cummins published standards and that lubricating oils that meet Cummins specifications have been used.

Cummins is not responsible for failures resulting from improper repair or the use of parts not approved by Cummins.

These Warranties are the sole Warranties of Cummins. There are no other Warranties, express or implied, or of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.



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
