Coverage

Products Warranted

This Warranty applies to Engines (4B) originally manufactured or distributed by Cummins Inc. ("Cummins") that are remanufactured by Cummins ReCon® delivered to the first retail purchaser on or after August 1, 1998 and marketed by Cummins ReCon® in the United States and Canada under the trademark "Cummins" or "Cummins ReCon®" for Frito Lay Step Van Applications.

Base Engine Warranty

This Warranty covers any Warrantable Failure of Cummins ReCon® 4B Series Engines which results, under normal use and service, from defects in workmanship or materials. This Coverage extends for two years or 50,000 miles (80,468 km) whichever occurs first, after the date of delivery of the Engine to the first retail purchaser.

Accessory Coverage

Accessory components supplied with the Cummins ReCon® 4B Engines are covered for six months/unlimited miles/km. Accessory components may include, but are not limited to: fan hubs, belt tensioners, alternators, starters, vacuum pumps, belts, accessory pulleys, hydraulic pumps, flywheels, ring gears, transmission adapters, water inlets, air/exhaust connections. These components and their respective mounting hardware, brackets, hoses, lines, etc. are covered by this Accessory Coverage.

Extended Major Components Warranty

The following components are covered for an additional two years, 50,000 miles (80,468 km):

Crankshaft	Camshaft
Cylinder Block	Connecting Rods

Extended Major Components Warranty includes parts and labor required to repair the Engine as a result of a Warrantable Failure of one of the listed Major Components.

Cummins ReCon® Responsibilities During Both Warranties

Cummins ReCon® will pay for all Cummins parts and labor required to repair the Engine as a result of a Warrantable Failure.

Only Cummins ReCon® Components or new genuine

Cummins parts and assemblies will be used in making the repair. Cummins ReCon® will also pay costs for reasonable maintenance items (oil, filters, antifreeze) that have been damaged, or require replacement, as a result of a Warrantable Failure.

All labor costs will be paid in accordance with Cummins published Standard Repair Time guidelines. Labor must be performed by an authorized Cummins Distributor or Dealer. Cummins ReCon® will pay reasonable labor cost for Engine removal and reinstallation when necessary to make the Warranty repair.

Owner Responsibilities During Both Warranties

Owner is responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Engine as specified in the applicable Cummins Operation and Maintenance Manuals.

Prior to the expiration of the applicable Warranty, Owner must give notice of any Warrantable Failure to a Cummins distributor or authorized dealer or other repair location approved by Cummins and deliver the Engine to such facility for repair. Locations are listed in the Cummins United States and Canada Sales and Service Directory.

Owner is responsible for communication expenses, meals, towing, lodging, travel, and incidental costs incurred by Owner or employees of Owner as a result of a Warrantable Failure.

Owner is responsible for "downtime" expenses, cargo damage and all business costs and losses resulting from a Warrantable Failure. **Cummins ReCon® is not responsible for incidental or consequential damages.**

Limitations

Cummins ReCon® is not responsible for failures resulting from Owner or Operator abuse or neglect, such as: operation without adequate coolant, fuel or lubricants; overfueling; overspeeding; lack of maintenance of lubricating, cooling or air intake systems; improper storage, starting, warm-up, run-in or shut-down practices; excessive progressive damage. Cummins ReCon® is also not responsible for failures caused by incorrect fuel or dirt, water or other contaminants in the fuel.

Before a claim for excessive oil consumption will be considered, Owner must submit adequate documentation to show that consumption exceeds Cummins published standards and that lubricating oils that meet Cummins specifications have been used.

Cummins ReCon® is not responsible for failures resulting from improper repair practices or the use of parts not approved by Cummins ReCon®.

These Warranties are the sole Warranties of Cummins ReCon®. There are no other Warranties, express or implied, or of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.



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
